



Conceptualising integration: Social inclusion and exclusion in diverse and multicultural societies

Post-conference PhD workshop April 4, 2020 – University of Akureyri, Iceland

Including new migrants in their host societies is one of the policy priorities in the European Union. Emerging both from migrants and hosts, integration is understood as multiple processes of interaction and participation creating conditions through which migrants can engage with their new community. This workshop invites papers that address conceptual and practical concerns and develop new critical understandings of integration, inclusion and exclusion.

The PhD workshop will be organized in conjunction with the conference **“The Role of Universities in Addressing Societal Challenges and Fostering Democracy: Inclusion, Migration and Education for Citizenship”** taking place at the **University of Akureyri on April 2-3, 2020**. The workshop will be held on April 4, 2020 at the University of Akureyri.

The workshop consists of students’ presentations followed by group discussions. Thus, the workshop provides the opportunity for doctoral students to discuss their ongoing work and to get feedback from invited academics and fellow participating students. Selected students will be required to deliver a written presentation (not more than 2000 words) by February 10, 2020. Invited professors participating in the workshop include **Elke Murdoch, Pamela Innes and Unnur Dís Skaptadóttir**.

Eligibility and Application procedure

We invite doctoral students from different fields of social sciences (sociology, anthropology, social work, economics, business studies, political science and law) whose research interest is related to topics of – broadly understood – integration and inclusion. The workshop is limited to 10 students and is free of charge. Selected students are exempted from the conference registration fee.
